TUGBOAT EXPERIENCE

Overnight aboard *Arthur Foss* for an immersive hands-on experience. Individuals, families and groups learn about its classic American story, neighboring historic vessels, and Lake Union's environs in the heart of modern Seattle.

Participants receive an orientation and tour from engine room to wheelhouse. Overnighters take advantage of standard 20th century tugboat crew amenities, including flush toilets, hot showers and amazing local views of Lake Union. Plan on bringing/making meals (or eating out) and other overnight necessities. Fresh linens and wool blankets provided.

Whether overnighing for one, two or more nights, the *Arthur Foss* overnight education program provides a slice of Puget Sound maritime history with accommodations.
